CITY OF TONTITOWN, WASHINGTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS

A RESOLUTION EXPRESING THE WILLINGNESS OF THE CITY OF TONTITOWN TO UTILIZE FEDERAL-AID TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM OR RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM FUNDS FOR THE SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT IN THE CITY OF TONTITOWN, ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown understands Federal-aid Transportation Alternatives Program or Recreational Trail Program funds are available at 80% federal participation and 20% local match to develop or improve the sidewalks along Ardemagni Road, between Baker and Liberty Road, in the City of Tontitown; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tontitown understands that Federal-aid Funds are available for this project on reimbursable basis, requiring work to be accomplished and proof of payment prior to actual monetary reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, this project, using federal funding, will be open and available for use by the general public and maintained by the applicant for the life of the project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Tontitown, Arkansas:

Section 1. The City of Tontitown will participate in accordance with its designated responsibility including maintenance of this project.

Section 2. The Mayor of Tontitown is hereby authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to expedite the construction of the above stated project.

Section 3. The City Council of Tontitown pledges its full support and hereby authorizes the Arkansas Department of Transportation to initiate action to implement this project.
