OFFICER TRAINING FOR 2024

- 4411 hours of combined training.
- Training for CID Sgt. Lindley and Det. Whitaker completed CSI and Forensic Investigation Plus Photography courses.
- Sgt. Hammons, Lt. McCollough and Chief Jenison all completed Arkansas Criminal Justice Institute's School of Law Enforcement Supervision, Officer Black completed Leadership Courses for front line supervisors, Officer Brondhaver became a certified field training officer, Officer Calico and Officer West became certified police snipers, Officer Lowe became a certified drug recognition expert "DRE", Officer Tucker completed the police academy, Captain Bowen completed FBI-LEEDA's Leadership Trilogy by completing the Supervisor Leadership Institute, Command Leadership Institute and Executive Leadership Institute.
- Officer's completed Training in Tactical Vehicle Intervention
- Active Shooter Training
- 3 officers were hired throughout the year and have been in field training either before the academy or after graduating the academy.

2024 NOTABLE EVENTS

- Officer Campbell and Capt. Bowen were able to attend Police Week in Washington DC and represented the Tontitown Police Department at the memorial. Funded by Tontitown FOP.
- Tontitown Police Department was the first department in Arkansas to have a police grappler system install on a vehicle.
- TPD FOP was able to help 29 kids through Shop With A Cop (\$300 per kid)
- Tontitown started and completed the first Tontitown Police Citizen Academy.
- Issued and Qualified with new rifles for everyone in the department.
- Built a shoot house for active shooter training.
- TPD was featured on ID discovery channel for stopping two dangerous felons in a U-Haul.

2024 NOTABLES CONTINUED

Increased our social media footprint from 380 to just under 10,000 followers which Sgt. Lindley manages extremely well.
